Site Accommodation setup



When starting a new site, temporary electrical installations are a must to get the site team off to a good productive start. Site Lighting



It is important that a site is fitted with suitable artificial lighting. Lighting can be used internally for general movement and working on the site itself, externally for illuminating entry, storage and circulation areas, and can also be an effective form of deterrent from trespassers. We feel LED is the best option for this application.

PAT Testing, 3 monthly

Site Power
